Instructions for the Application Form

1. General Instructions

- Please complete the form in Japanese.
- The space provided in the columns can be adjusted if necessary.
- In addition to this form, a curriculum vitae and a list of publications are required. There are no prescribed forms for these documents (please refer to 10. on the application guidelines).

2. 受入教員 (Host Researcher)

- The host researcher should be selected from the full-time researchers at the Rekihaku. The host researchers will support the fellow throughout the program, from their application to their arrival in Japan, and during their stay, until their return to their home institution.

3. 氏名 (Name)

- Please provide the applicants' name as indicated in the applicants' passport and in Japanese (Katakana). The candidate's name written in his/ her mother tongue may be added if desired.

6. 所属機関の長の許可(Permission From Supervisor)

Please check the box after obtaining permission for the application by the applicant's supervisor at their home institution.

7. 専攻 (Field of Research)

- The field of research must correspond to one of the four research divisions at Rekihaku: museum science, history, archaeology or folklore.

8. 主な学歴 (Educational Background)

- Please list the applicant's educational background, starting from the admission to university or college.
- Please provide the month and year of the admission and completion of each program or degree.

9. 主な研究歴 (Research Experience)

- Please list any previous employments in research related positions.
- Please provide the month and year of the beginning and the termination of each employment.

10. 希望期間 (Proposed Duration of Stay)

- The proposed duration of stay should be between 14 and up to 90 days during the period stated in the Application Guidelines.

- The proposed duration of stay should start with the day of arrival in, and extend to the day of departure from Japan. For example, for candidates from Europe or North America it may take 2 days from departure to arrival. Please be sure to provide the date on which the applicant arrives in and departs from Japan.
- Please also provide the number of days of the proposed stay in Japan.

11. 研究課題名 (Research Project Title)

- Please provide the title of the research project the applicants proposes to conduct at the Rekihaku in both Japanese and English.

12. 研究の概要 (Outline of Research Project)

- Please briefly outline the proposed research project.

13. 本館の研究・事業との関わり (Connection to the Museum's Research and Activities)

- If an applicant plans to participate in any of the museum's projects etc., such as Institute-based Projects, please indicate the title of the project under “プロジェクト等”.
- Please describe how extending an invitation to the applicant will contribute to the purpose of this program, including its future prospects.
